

Gate Entry Instructions – Non-resident Members

Below are the instructions for entering and exiting the Cutter Creek property when the main entrance gates are closed.

Entry

Upon arrival at the front entrance of the property, slowly approach the gate.

Pull to the access keypad and swipe your access card or enter your personal 4-digit PIN. Note: If you are using your 4-digit PIN, you must enter # first, followed by the 4 digits. (ex. #1234)

The gate will open.

Enter slowly through the gate.

Please follow all traffic and directional signs throughout the property. Note that the speed limit throughout the property is 25 mph. Please be mindful of golf carts, pedestrians, and children at play as you drive through the property.

If you have forgotten your card or 4-digit PIN, you can press the directory number for the Clubhouse to access the Golf Shop during business hours to get buzzed onto the property.

Exit

When leaving the property, drive slowly as you approach the exit gate.

The gate will automatically open when it picks up your vehicle approaching.

DO NOT pull up too closely to the gate or approach too fast, so as not to impede the gate from opening fully so you may exit.

Exit slowly through the gate.

REMINDER: Never share your access card or PIN with anyone. If your card or PIN has been lost or compromised, please notify the Golf Shop immediately so that it can be deactivated and a new card issued. The cost of lost cards is \$20.00 each and will be charged to your account.
